RE: COU Academic Colleague and Alternate

Each Ontario university is represented by two individuals on the Council of Ontario Universities (COU): the executive head and an academic colleague. According to the constitution, the academic colleague is to be “selected for membership by the academic senate or equivalent senior academic body, from among academic staff who are current members of that body or who could be appointed to it while serving as a colleague and who shall hold office for a term of two years, renewable.”

In the spring of 2006, the UOIT Academic Council named Dr. Brian Campbell as its academic colleague for a two year term. At the same time, Dr. Mark Green was named as the academic colleague alternate for a two year term. Professors Campbell and Green have done outstanding jobs in this role in representing our interests and contributing to the improvement of higher education more generally. In the interests of maintaining continuity with this body, I have asked them to stand for reappointment. I therefore recommend:

that Academic Council name Dr. Brian Campbell, Dean of Graduate Studies, as UOIT Academic Colleague and Dr. Mark Green, Faculty of Science, as UOIT Academic Colleague Alternate, for terms ending June 30, 2010.
