
Program highlights

What will I study?

PJ (Kindergarten to Grade 6)

This Primary/Junior (PJ) program integrates technology into mathematics, coding, science, arts, language, social studies and physical education. We emphasize building community, equity, diversity and teaching for inclusion, mental health, online learning and reflective practice.

IS (Grade 7 to 12)

This Intermediate/Senior (IS) program focuses on digital literacies, learning and development, coding and communication, online learning, equity, diversity and teaching for inclusion, mental health and reflective practice.

Applicants are required to have two teachable subject areas. We offer:

- Biology
- · Chemistry or Physics
- English
- · General Science

- · Health and Physical Education
- History
- Mathematics

Eligibility

Applicants must hold an undergraduate degree from a recognized university and have a minimum 3.0 GPA in their best 10 full-year or best 20 half-year courses at the time of application. Preference will be given to applicants with a four-year honours degree.

Future IS teachers (grades 7 to 12) must complete the equivalent of five full-year courses for the first teachable subject area and three full-year courses in the second teachable subject with a minimum 2.7 GPA.
